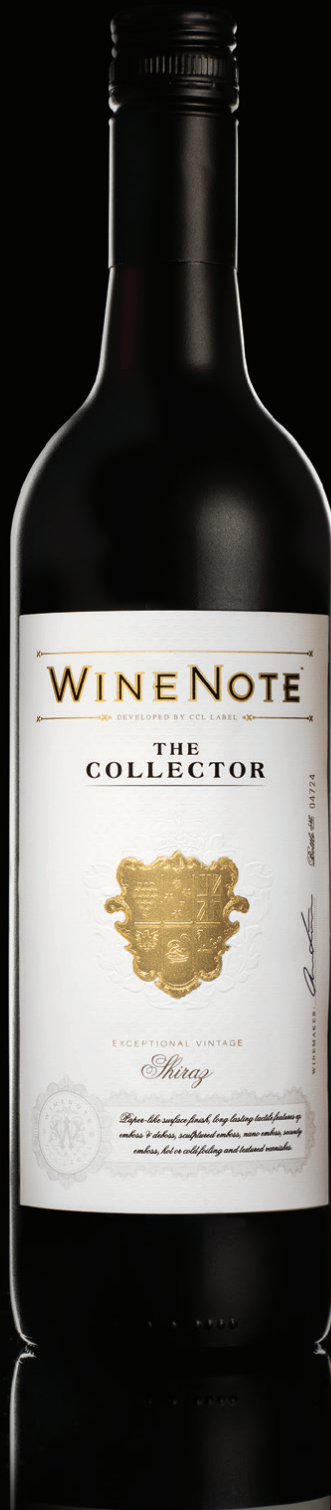

## JUDGES

### JEFF BYRNE – Byrne Farm

Jeff Byrne, has a 20+ year history of wine making in New South Wales, starting his career at Tower Estate for the late Len Evans followed by 11 years as chief winemaker for Agnew Wines, overseeing the brands Audrey Wilkinson, Poole's Rock and Cockghter's Ghost. In 2019, Jeff and his family made the decision to pour his passion for winemaking into his own business, moving his family from the Hunter Valley to the cool climate, high altitude region of Orange, New South Wales where he continues his winemaking and consulting career. Originally from Nova Scotia, Canada, Jeff completed a science degree at the University of New Brunswick in his native land before moving to Australia in 1999, followed by a degree in Wine Science through Charles Sturt University, which he graduated in 2008. Jeff and his wife Bridgette with their three daughters Caitlin, Lauren and Bree have now purchased a small 40 acre property in the Nashdale region of Orange, aptly named "Byrne Farm", their property has a wonderful one hundred year history of being a productive apple and cherry orchard. It is also the historical site for some of the very first vineyard plantings in the region. Based at 900m on the foot of Mt Canobolas, the rich, chocolate ferrosol soils make it the ideal location to plant a new vineyard, focusing on Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Sparkling production.

### XANTHE HATCHER — Agnew Wines

After growing up in Sydney and studying a dual winemaking and viticultural degree, Xanthe supported her studies with a wine retail management role that fuelled her passion, leading her in 2009 to embark on her winemaking career in the Hunter Valley. Initially with prominent Hunter brand Hungerford Hill, Xanthe was later invited to join family-owned Agnew wines in 2013. Working through the ranks, Xanthe was granted the opportunity to become Chief Winemaker for Agnew Wines in 2019, her current role, which she fulfils with much commitment, gratitude, and pride. The Agnew Wines Pokolbin winery processes 2000 tonnes of wine grapes annually. In her role, Xanthe is custodian of three brands in the Agnew portfolio, Cockfighters Ghost, Poole's Rock and Audrey Wilkinson, for which she is just the 4th company winemaker since 1866. Five high-profile company vineyards similarly fall under Xanthe's governance, with all but the McLaren Vale 'Chairman's' vineyard, located in the Hunter Valley. The Pokolbin winery is well equipped to produce wine under contract, by which Xanthe manages the wine style requirements and the business relationships with over fifteen New South Wales wine companies.

### MICHAEL ANDERSON — Langtons

Michael has over 10 years in the Australian wine trade, in that time working for two of the nation's most recognisable wine retailers. His journey in wine began in the Hunter Valley before moving into the online retail arm of Laithwaite's Wines where he was the wine writer, tasting panel member and in-house wine education specialist. More recently, Michael took over the prestigious role of Head of Langton's Auctions and Secondary Market where he oversees an enviable range of the world's finest wines and producers. Education has always been a big piece of the puzzle for Michael, who has completed his WSET Diploma, AWRI Advanced Wine Assessment Course and 3 vintages in South Australia's McLaren Vale region, as well judging at the Sydney Royal Wine Show.

As far as formal qualifications go, she is currently progressing through her Bachelor of Wine Science degree at Charles Sturt University and her knowledge and experience in wine grows every day. Reneé has hosted numerous wine events around the region where her experience as a performer along with her knowledge, enthusiasm, energy and finely tuned palate serves her well as a natural host. A true devotee to the Mudgee region, she is excited about learning as much as she can from this renowned panel of wine judges. In the future, she looks forward to one day angering an entire nation by launching her own label 'French Wines'.

## TOM DUNSTAN — Bunnamagoo Estate Wines

Tom Dunstan has been in the wine industry for 10 years since his first vintage at Cumulus wines in Orange where he returned for a second year. Since Orange he has worked in Rutherglen (Warrabilla Wines), spent a year as a Gin sales rep (NSW) for Kangaroo Island Spirits, then made the move to Mudgee where he worked at Logans for 3 and half years and has been a winemaker for the last year and a half at Bunnamagoo Estate. Originally From the North Shore of Sydney, Tom completed a Wine Science degree and then a Viticulture Degree at Charles Sturt University finishing the later in 2017.
